JETER AND WILLS PLACE 3RD & 4TH IN HOT HUNDREDS

IRVINE, CA—VS sprinters **Carmelita Jeter** and **Will Hills** continued to work their way up the improvement curve with 3rd and 4th place 100 Meter Dash finishes in the showpiece events at the 22nd annual **Steve Scott Invitational** at UC-Irvine. Going to the starting line, “Jet” was seeded 7th in an outstanding field that included 2004 200 meter silver medalist Susanthika Jayasinghe, 2005 NCAA 100m semi-finalist Melinda Smedley, 2000 Olympic 200m semi-finalist Louise Ayetoche, 2004 World Junior 100m silver medalist Jasmine Baldwin, and former Arizona State star, Porchea Carroll. Despite a good start, Carmelita was in 6th place at 70 meters, then closed like her nickname to finish 3rd in **11.65** behind Jayasinghe’s 11.37 and ahead of Ayetoche, Baldwin, and Carroll.

The Men’s 100 Meters field was headlined by 9.99 sprinter Coby Miller and national qualifiers Ryan Mosley and Brandon Evans. Running his first 100 of the 2006 season, **Will Hills** finished 4th behind those three with an encouraging time of **10.73** into a -1.6mps wind. Miller, Mosley, and Evans ran 10.43, 10.67, and 10.70 respectively.

Later in the meet, Carmelita and Will both ran **24.13** and **21.72** season bests for 7th and 5th places in the fast sections of the 200 meters. “Jet” still wasn’t done for the day as she led off the VS Women’s 4x 400m Relay with a **58.5** leg, followed by teammates **Aleksandra Deren (56.5)**, **Chris Gentile (61.6)**, and **Roseline Agboke (56.7)** to win Heat-2 in **3:54.01**. Earlier, “Roz” had finished 2nd in the Women’s 800 Meters in **2:11.80** while Chris ran a forgettable 1500 after being up all night with food poisoning.
